






#### Innovation – Sensor Cleaning Station

- Fully integrated cleaning system from Kardex.
- Removes dust and contamination.
- Each robot drives to the cleaning station once a day.
   The blow-off nozzles are activated automatically.
- After a few seconds, the cleaning process is finished.
- The robots can work without interruption for longer, which increases the overall availability of the system.

#### Innovation – Kardex Pick&Pack integrated AutoStore workstation

- Pick robot on gantry serves 2 AS ports
- Up to 3 sizes of order-cartons
- Up to 400 order-cartons/h
- Cartons are erected, filled, closed and labelled
- Port to port operations possible
- Very compact footprint




# Geographical expansion and market split












### Kardex in the Intralogistics Market – 3 Years ago




